Minimum Requirements: Candidates, at time of application, must have:

- 1) diploma from accredited high school or GED;
- 2) 1000 hours of municipal police experience;
- 3) Act 120 Certification under Municipal Police Officers Education and Training Act;
- 4) U.S. Citizenship;
- 5) valid PA driver's license;
- 6) physically & mentally fit to perform full duties of police officer;
- 7) at least twenty-one years old.

Successful applicants must meet all requirements of Borough's Civil Service Rules including background & credit investigation, & if selected, be required to successfully pass a physical & psychological examination. Applications are available at www.newbethlehemboro.com.

Required Physical Agility Test requirements follow and will be held on May 28 and May 29, 2019, at 3 PM at Tri-Co Health and Fitness at 301 Wood Street, New Bethlehem, PA 16242 for those officers who meet qualifications and have received written authorization. Written tests for those who pass the physical tests will be scheduled during the first week of June, most likely on June 4th and 6th.

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Physical Agility Tests for Police Officer

THE FOLLOWING PHYSICAL EXERCISES ARE REQUIRED OF ALL APPLICANTS FOR THE POSITION OF FULL TIME POLICE OFFICER. THOSE PERSONS WHO FAIL TO SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE ANY ONE OF THE EXERCISES WILL BE ELIMINATED FROM THE SELECTION PROCESS. REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL TESTS MAY BE MODIFIED BASED ON MPOETC, OLD STANDARD AND MODIFIED COOPER AGE AND GENDER STANDARDS*. ALL FOUR EVENTS MUST BE COMPLETED IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER WITHIN A TWO-HOUR TIME LIMIT.

4. 30 SECOND TRIGGER PULL

Within a 30-second time limit per hand, an applicant is required to repeatedly pull fifteen (15) times per hand the trigger of a double action nonfunctional revolver with arms horizontally extended. Graded Pass/Fail.
